Disciple Mentorship: Mentees appreciate their TE mentor's calls and prayerful encouragement as they give account of their disciple making efforts. Alfred has 12 new children attending a home cell group. One neighbor's parents are prohibiting the TE mentee from sharing the Gospel with their daughter. Another Muslim has accepted that Christ is the son of God.

Training: Successful completion with safe travels, of the Bible and Literacy 2025/26 school year in-service trainings (15 total). Knowledge of the Old Testament and Phonics is being transferred from the teachers to the children. Third term and final exams from April 6th-18th.

Recruitment: Applications are coming. Prayers for development of an effective, productive team, glorifying God.

Curriculum: Curriculum is being designed by competent volunteers. We are taking care to create new content so it can be shared with the Liberians, Ghanaians and others who desire it.

Communications: We are grateful that the Sierra Leone team now has faster internet opening the door for several more efficient communication options. We are practicing clear communication using 5 W's and 1 H. (Who, What, When, Where, Why and How), which is new to some of the team members.

Administrative: Sierra Leone Board Meeting April 4th and US meeting April 13th.

Before now, the village only had a single teacher that could read and write, which made every documentation or literate work to pass through him. With this intervention of Transformational Education, scholarships were given to two individuals to study a full Teachers Certificate Program at the Makripodis Bible College.

This intervention ⁽¹⁾ is greatly helping in transforming the narrative in Monogoray village as the scholarship recipients are fully implementing the knowledge gained by teaching the kids in the village with the support of Transformation Education.
