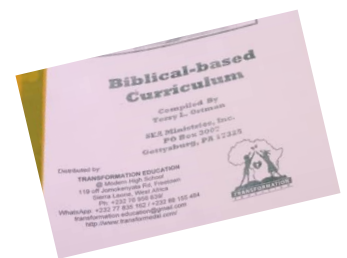
Next Steps:
