Recently I heard **Priscilla Shirer leadership advice to young people**. Her answer was both simple and profound:

"Value, honor, and maximize the process—the situation you are currently in. Each stage is necessary to develop the character and structure you will need for the next phase. Appreciate the process, and don't try to jump ahead."

Priscilla illustrated this truth through the story of **Naaman (2 Kings 5)**. Although he was a great military commander, Naaman's leprosy could only be healed when he **humbled himself and obeyed God's instructions** through the prophet Elisha. **God used the process to shape his heart before He restored his body.**

She also shared her own family testimony. Her grandfather struggled with alcoholism and made a living selling alcohol. One day, a coworker introduced him to **Jesus Christ, and that encounter changed the direction of his life**. A few years later, his wife and four children also came to know Christ. One of those children became **Dr. Tony Evans, whose ministry has now influenced generations of believers around the world**. One life transformed by Christ became a blessing to countless others.

That testimony beautifully reflects the **vision of Transformation Education**. We are investing in teachers today, trusting God to transform **children, families, churches, communities, and future generations** through their faithful witness.

The process of developing **Bible and English literacy curriculum is time-consuming and often challenging**, but we press on with confidence, knowing that **the fruit of these labors will continue to spread far and wide** as teachers are equipped to **disciple the next generation**.
