Alfred Kanu's Transformation is Creating a Ripple Effect in His Community

Before joining the Transformation Education Student Teacher Degree Scholarship Program, Alfred tutored children in his neighborhood. After

receiving a scholarship and completing Bible and discipleship training, he

began to see his calling expand. With his pastor's blessing, Alfred launched Bible studies in three communities—reaching both adults and children—and planted a church that now has 50 members. He has also trained others to help lead these growing groups.

In addition to community outreach, Alfred teaches weekly Bible assemblies at three schools, students now memorize Bible verses and hear Bible stories each week. Within his own 4th-grade classroom, Alfred disciples his students through Bible Sharing and Testimony Journals. As they write and share their personal reflections, they are inspired to share God's Word with others—continuing the cycle of transformation.

Alfred came top in his class of with a grade point average of 4.86.

Looking Ahead: July-August Training

- Looking ahead, we are welcoming 15 new student teachers, all of whom
 will receive full scholarships funded through general donations. Unlike
 last year, these students will not be individually assigned to sponsors.
- They will serve in the same **10 partner schools** where our original cohort is currently teaching. The **first group will mentor the new student teachers**, building leadership capacity and ensuring a stronger implementation of what they've learned.
- Following the completion of summer classes (our first term of the college program), we are preparing
 for a 5-day Bible Intensive. This year's training, for the first time, includes three days led by
 Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF). We believe this addition will deeply enrich our spiritual
 training focus.
